

Winner emerges from national finals for Bauhinia's sixth Cooking for Mom contest

After fierce competition, little chef Luo Yixuan from Qingyuan emerged as the national winner. At the live show, Luo shared, "Through Bauhinia's Cooking for Mom contest, I got to pour my whole heart into cooking for the very first time and learned how to use gas appliances safely. Most importantly, I realised that cooking is no easy feat. I now understand how hard my mom works every day, and am determined to care for her more."
