


The Hong Kong and China Gas Company Limited Attends the 19th International Conference & Exhibition on Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG2019)

(6 April 2019) LNG2019 kicked off at Shanghai World Expo Exhibition & Convention Center on 2 April. Also known as the Olympics of the LNG field, the event attracted over 250 international exhibitors, 550 participating corporations and over 11,000 professional attendees from over 80 countries.
